VOLUNTEERS INVITED TO BUILD THE SECRET-LAMOILLE TRAIL
ON NATIONAL TRAILS DAY

Would-be trailbuilders are invited to join the Northeastern Nevada Stewardship Group 9AM Saturday, June 5th, to begin construction of the Secret-Lamoille Trail. Volunteers will meet at the Lamoille Canyon trailhead for the S-L Trail, at the pullout above the Powerhouse Picnic Grounds. The event is part of National Trails Day, being celebrated by communities and volunteer groups across the country.

Volunteers should anticipate working for about four hours, and should dress for the weather. The work will entail digging, raking, potentially removing roots and/or rocks, and other relatively heavy work. Work gloves, boots, and long pants are a good idea; shorts and sandals are not. Bring water and snacks. Lunch will be provided.

Funding for the event is provided by the Northeastern Nevada Stewardship Group, with contributions from the US Forest Service, Event Source Inc. and the Friends of the Secret-Lamoille Trail.
